

Somerset Shark Reminders

- Please get your swimmer to practice on time – it helps the coaches and benefits your child.
- Children must be picked up at the conclusion of their practice. We cannot be responsible for children after their assigned practice is over.
- Only Somerset Swim and Tennis members may stay and enjoy the pool after practice. Please remember that a child **MUST** be 13 or older to stay without a parent or guardian.
- The baby pool will be open during swim practice for toddlers **UNDER PARENTAL SUPERVISION ONLY**. The baby pool will be closed during swim meets.
- If you have a little one, please be sure your child is wearing appropriate swim wear if they are still in the stage of accidents. We understand they do happen but ask that you ensure your child is covered. This will help alleviate the need to shut down the pool and avoid unnecessary expense.
- Children unable to swim the length of the pool and/or 4 years of age as of June 1st, will be unable to participate in evening meets, but will be able to participate in our own “mini-meets” the day of the meet at home during their regular practice time.
- Every parent **MUST** volunteer for **2 volunteer positions**.
 - If your child is under 10, you must volunteer in the bullpen for one of your positions.
 - If your child is 6 & under, you must volunteer in the 6 & under bullpen for one of your positions.
 - Please remember there are 2 shifts at every meet – parents with younger children should volunteer for the early shift.
